Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

When I was a kid there was one thing you could count on when I woke up in the morning, I started every day with a healthy dose of Captain Kangaroo. Bunny Rabbit, Mr. Moose, and Dancing Bear, were my friends, as was Mr. Greenjeans and all the other characters of this long running series. Not that I was

exclusivist, Romper Room, The Funny Company, and catchy commercials (Oh, I wish I was and Oscar Meyer Weiner...) all hold a special place in my heart, but Captain Kangaroo was my generations' Mr. Rogers. (Not surprisingly, they were friends and fellow advocates for children and children's educational television, even appearing on each other's shows.)

I think what made him and his show so special, was that he and his castmates told stories that helped us learn about life and values in a down to earth way that was fun and easy to understand, sometime in the form of actual storybooks.


